SCHOOL

Why Millennium Institute of Sciences is the Best Choice

With a firm determination, Millennium Institute of Sciences started to nurture class XI from the academic session of 2007 believing that success is not the achievement but the quality of journey. In her maiden appearance at HSE 2009 the Institute produce 188 first class students with 3 position holders, in 2010 there were 195 first class students with 5 position holders, in 2011, it produce 332 1st divisioners including 4 position holders, 2 subject topper with 340 letter mark scorers re-affirmed its development, in 2012, 223 1st divisioners, including 5 position holders with hundreds of letter mark scorers. From the year 2013 to 2016 council of higher secondary education Manipur adopted CCE examination pattern and Millennium Institute of Sciences proved its worth with an astounding pass percentage of 98.42%, this success story continues in the following years with 98.06%, 97.06%. During this period the Institute excelled with centuries of letter mark scorers and a mind blowing 100 out of 100 in Mathematics by one of our achievers. In 2017 council re-introduced the earlier pattern of examination and MIS stole the show with 2 (two) 2nd position holders and 1 (one) 3rd position Holder. In 2018 MIS continued to make its presence felt with 4 position holders, 3rd, 5th, 11th and 18th. In 2019 the Institute bagged 4 position the 7th, 16th, 17th and 20th. In 2020 MIS continued to make its presence felt with 4 position holders, 12th, 14th, 14th and 19th. In 2021, no rank was awarded by Council due to Covid Pandemic. In 2022 the Institute bagged 2 position the 2nd position holder and 19th position holder with an astounding pass percentage of 97.46%. In the recently declared Higher Secondary Examination results of 2023, the Institute bagged 13th, 17th and 20th position. Thus every year, Millennium Institute of Sciences manage to register its presence and the journey continues with the head held high and the heart filled with a brighter Hope.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

The selection procedure for admission in Class-XI may be through an admission test or through cut off mark basis or first come first serve basis or through lottery as the authority deemed necessary, the information of which will be notified in due time.

ELIGIBILITY

Students who have cleared HSLC Examination or equivalent of any recognised board approved by Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur securing at least 55% on aggregate or announced by the institute from time to time may apply.

COURSES OF STUDIES'

The institute offers the following courses of studies English, Manipuri / Alternative English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Health & Physical Education, Mathematics & Computer Science.

COMPULSORY SUBJECTS:

English, Manipuri/Alternative English

The following combinations may be chosen above the compulsory subjects.

Group A

Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics

Group B

Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science

Group C

Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Health & Physical Education

HOSTEL

Separate hostels for boys and girls with comfortable and conducive stay-in facilities have been set up. Keeping in mind the view convenience and safety of the girls hostellers, the girls hostel is stationed in the school premises. It can accommodate 100 students and the boys hostel can accommodate 100 students.

APPLICATION FORM

The Prospectus and application form can be obtained from the institution on payment of a non-refundable amount fixed by the institution.

There shall be limited seat reservation for BPL students and certified handicap students. Details shall be announced by the Principal, MIS at the time of admission.

APPLICATION FORM SUBMISSION

The following documents should be enclosed at the time of submission of duly filled application form to the institution on or before the date fixed by the institutional authority.

- Attested photocopy of provisional certificate of passing HSLC or equivalent examination.
- Attested photocopy of mark sheet of HSLC or equivalent exam.
- 3 recent passport photographs & 1 stamp size.
- Attested photocopies of BPL card, if applied for.
- Attested photocopies of handicap certificate, if applied for.

ADMISSION TEST

The students whose application forms are found complete and all correct shall be issued Admit Card. Students who receive Admit Card shall appear a written test on date announced by the Institution. Questions will be set on General English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics from the syllabus of Class X of Board of Secondary Education, Manipur. Duration of examination will be 1 hours and total mark will be 100 mark. All questions will be multiple choice type.

SELECTION & DECLARATION OF RESULT

Selection of candidates will be based on the admission test exam of the eligible candidate. In case if equal cumulative results arise, subject wise emphasis will be given on priority basis Science-Mathematics-General English. Result of the test will be declared on the same day of admission test. The result will also be made available in the school website (www.millenniuminst.com) and local daily papers. No personal intimation or correspondence will be made in this regard.

PERSONAL INTERVIEW

After declaration of selection result, an interview of selected candidates will be conducted on a day fixed by authority and it may continue for a few days if required. Candidates should be accompanied by their parents/guardians at the time of interview and it is mandatory. This interview will assess personality, conduct, discipline and behaviour of the student. This personnel interview shall be a very important interaction of parents/guardian with the school authority in regards of their wards' future in the school. Candidates are to appear in formal dress. Selected candidates are required to produce the original certificates and documents at the time of the interview. Any students who fail to appear at the interview on the given date, shall have his selection canceled. For any issue arise regarding admission, the decision of Principal, MIS shall be final.

PAYMENT OF FEES (ADMISSION FEES)

Candidates selected for admission after personal interview should collect bank-deposit slips from the School office. Fees are to be paid at the Indian Bank, Paona Bazar, Imphal on or before the last date fixed by the institute. The counter foil of the bank receipt(school copy) should be deposited to the office of the institute immediately. If the receipts/counterfoil (school copy) is not submitted in time the particular candidate will be taken as "not admitted": Right for the admission cannot be claimed by those selected candidates who fail to pay the admission fees and submit the school copy by the due date.

(TUITION FEES)

Any students admitted to the Institute need to pay tuition fee of 12 months for each session.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

The Institution authority reserves the right to cancel the admission of a candidate if the information furnished by him/her are found incorrect or if the documents are found forged or fake or if he/she engage in any activity that affects the institute.

NB. Incomplete application form will summarily be rejected. Form submitted after last date shall not be accepted. Copies of documents attached shall not be returned once submitted.

ADMISSION WITHDRAWAL & TRANSFER

- Once admitted, fees shall not be refunded.
- Any student seeking transfer before the end of the academic session shall have to pay monthly fees and other relevant fees for the full term. Otherwise transfer shall not be allowed and no transfer certificate will be issued.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR TOPPERS

Toppers' scholarship will be given only to the top 20 position holders of HSLC exam (BOSEM), if they apply for admission in the institution. The scholarship includes:

- Free admission fee and Tuition fee
- Book Grant.
- Free school uniforms.
- Monthly cash scholarships declared by the Institution from time to time.

MILLENNIUM MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

 - And befitting Cash Prizes to the students securing position from 4th-20th Position in the Council Higher Secondary Examination.
- Merit scholarship of ₹ 1,000/-, ₹ 500/ and ₹ 300 per month shall be offered to the students of the institute who stood 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively in the class XI Examination conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education Manipur, if they are not recipients of toppers scholarship.
- Incentive Award shall also be given to every teacher of the department(s) which produce student(s) securing highest mark in the subject of the said department in Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur.
- Special prize(s) shall be given to the most regular and disciplined student(s) of the institution.
- **Khuraijam Netrajit Singh Memorial Gold Medal:** shall be given to the best performer of the institute on the HSE Final Examination provided the student is a position holder in the top 20 list declared by the COHSEM. The prize is donated by Managing Committee Millennium Institute of Sciences.
- **Mutum Gautam Memorial Meritorious Award:** A cash prize of ₹ 5,000/- shall be given to the Highest Mark Scorer of the institute in the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by COHSEM. The award is donated by Mutum Manglemba Singh (Father), Mutum (o) I. Bhanumati Devi (Mother) & Mutum Sharda Devi (Younger Sister).

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

UNIQUE INTERACTION PROGRAM

Guardians and role models play very important role in cultivating talents of students by inducing well disciplined habits to students. So as to make the students achieve success in life after leaving the Institute, MIS is organizing Interaction Programme in two ways:

- a) Regularly there will be teachers, guardians and students interaction programme after every terminal examination to understand every individual's potential and behaviour. Solutions will be prepared for inducing qualities to the students.
- b) Students of this world require taste and experience with professional and leaders to achieve their aims in life. The institute will give an opportunity for students to interact with successful personalities in different fields. This will be an image in their mind and heart to achieve success.

RULE & REGULATIONS

1. All the students should wear complete uniform prescribed by the institute and must always be in possession of their identity card in the institute. Every girl should wear their prescribed colour of ribbons according to their class and their respective house ribbon with their house T-shirt. However, use of cosmetics such as nail polish, lipsticks, uncombed hairstyles & any extra ordinary beautification are not allowed in the Institute. Every Boy student should have his hair neatly cut & well combed.
2. All the students should attend every lecture, seminar, practical class and academic exercise prescribed for the course and any other activities taken up from time to time by the Institute/authority. In case of non-attendance, application stating the reason for not attending must be presented to the Principal immediately or to the Teacher in-charge in case Principal is engaged in other activities.
3. All students must reach the Institute at 8:00 am sharp and remain in their respective classrooms until 2:00 pm except during the time of recess or when instructed by the authority.
4. Use of drugs, alcohols, smoke, khashi, and any other intoxicants items/product by the student in school uniform inside as well as outside the school premises is strictly prohibited. Any student found indulging in such acts or any other indiscipline activity is liable to be expelled immediately from the institution.
5. MIS reserves the right to collect fines individually or from group in case of any disciplinary actions or damages or loss of property of the institution by the students.
6. Every student must be present in all examination, functions and activities organised by the school/Institute, as it is strictly mandatory, 75% in attendance is required for appearing in any examinations. If not he/she will be penalised. Severe punishment may also be given in non-reasonable application of leave of absence in time and also for any disciplinary act, such as mischief behavior, use of unfair means during examinations and the non-response to any academic activities.
7. Guardians/Parents are requested to contact the Principal, MIS/Teacher-in - charge regularly regarding attendance and progress of their wards. Every Student must check the notice board regularly for any update/notice issued by the Institute/authority. If any student is found to be absent from the classes continuously for 15 days without any written application from the student verified by the respective parents to the Principal; his/her name will be struck off from the register i.e. the admission will be treated cancelled.
8. Carrying of Cell Phones/electronic gadgets by any student is not allowed within the school premises and if found, in any case they shall be punished and the device will be immediately dismantled.
9. If students are found roaming outside the school premises in the school uniform, then they must accept the punishment given by the authority of the Institution.
10. For any issue, the decision of the school authority shall be final. The school authority reserves the right to change/amend the Rules & Regulations at any point of time depending on the prevailing situations even without prior notice.

In case of any untoward situation like pandemic etc. mode of payment of fees will be done after due notification by the Principal, according to the need of the hour.

MILLENNIUM HOSTEL

Millennium Institute of Sciences houses the most congenial and very decent hostel facility for boys and girls separately. The hostel facility is within the school campus in Kwakeithel Mayaikoibi, Imphal for Girls and at Patsoi campus for Boys. Campus surroundings are well maintained and is surrounded by concrete walls. The hostel meets the requirements of the present day students with special care for healthy and hygienic environment to ensure best possible grooming under the patronage of the Principal and the allied staff.

Safe and Secure Campus :

Millennium Institute of Sciences understands the importance of a safe and secure environment. All the entry and exit points are manned by well-trained security guards. CCTVs are positioned at the entrances and the campus. No one can enter without proper authorization and prior permission.

First Aid and Medical Care :

We have First Aid Medical Kit available in the hostel and a well-trained nurse is stationed in the hostel 247. Hostel Wardens and Nurse accompany the sick residents to Hospital as and when required and medical attention is delivered according to doctors.

* Personal mobile phones are not allowed, however residents are given fixed time to talk to parents/guardians under the supervision of Hostel Wardens.

ROOMS

- Rooms are subject to check by Principal/Chief-Warden/ Warden at any time.
- Hostellers are expected to maintain silence in the room and the corridors.
- After 10:30 PM, every student is expected to be in her room and maintain silence.
- Students are expected to keep their rooms, bathroom and surroundings clean and tidy. They are not supposed to disfigure the walls.
- Lights and fans should be switched off when leaving the rooms.

MESS

A well maintained, hygienic and well-furnished mess with expert cooks serving children healthy sumptuous food is another attraction of the hostel.

- Students are not allowed to take-out the kitchen utensils, crockery and cutlery from the dining hall under any circumstance.
- Residents are required to be punctual for dinner. Catering staff will not be expected to provide meals before or after the fixed timings.
- Wastage of food is strictly prohibited.
- Residents must eat in the dining room. Sick students may be allowed to have their meal in their rooms only with prior permission.

Wholesome meals are served. A hosteller is expected to come for meals in the dining hall properly attired. Meals are not served outside the dining hall except in case of indisposition.

- Breakfast : 6:30 AM. to 7:40 A.M.
- Lunch : 11:40 A.M. to 12:40 P.M.
- Evening Meal/ Snacks : 3:10 P.M. to 3:40 P.M.
- Dinner : 6:30 P.M. to 8:30 P.M.

Hostel Rules And Regulations

GENERAL RULES

- Since it is a privilege to gain admission to the Millennium hostel, hostellers are expected to maintain excellence in academics. Further, they are expected to attend all lectures, tutorials & tests.
- Shortage in attendance, poor academic performance and lack of participation in cocurricular and extracurricular activities will be viewed seriously.
- Staying away from hostel without prior intimation or approval, valid reason or authorization is a serious breach of Hostel Discipline will be liable to lose the Hostel seat and may not be considered for admission in the hostel even in the following year(s).
- Hostellers must maintain proper decorum in the hostel. They should behave properly with the staff and their fellow hostellers. Hostellers are expected to dress in an appropriate manner while visiting the dining hall, visitors' room and other common spaces in the hostel or school campus.
- Severe disciplinary action will be taken against students who break rules or abet other students in breaking the rules or in breaking the rules or in undermining the discipline of the hostel.
- Defacing walls, doors, corridors and cupboards by writing, painting or pasting posters, notes etc. with glue/tape/nails etc. is not allowed. Any violation, whatever the extent, will lead severe disciplinary action.
- Hostellers are advised not to bring jewellery/ valuables or keep large sums of money in their rooms. The hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss.
- As a zero-tolerance policy, Smoking, consuming liquor and drugs are strictly prohibited. The hostellers are not allowed to gamble, to consume intoxicants (narcotics, alcoholic beverages, smoking etc.), nor are they allowed to have possession of them in the hostel premises and violation of this rule shall lead to immediate expulsion.
- Roll call will be taken at 6.30 p.m. daily and all hostellers should be present unless prior leave has been taken. No hostellers must leave the hostel after the roll call. Violation of this rule could lead to expulsion.
- The permission of the Principal/Chief-Warden must be obtained for taking part in any cultural/ sports events outside college, hostellers are not to take any type of work or course without specific prior permission of the warden.
- Every boarder should report back in the hostel before hostel timings, as notified by the hostel authority. While going out of campus, proper entries have to be made in OUT-CAMPUS register with Warden.
- All the hosteller must clear the **necessary fees in time**.
- The hostellers are **not allowed to leave the campus** except for attending normal classes in school and tuition in MACCS. If any incumbent is found to leave the hostel for any matter other than the cited above without permission from the warden/ authority, then stem disciplinary actions will be taken, liable to expulsion.
- ***No hostellers are permitted to take private tuition from any centre or individual other than the MACCS run by the authority of the school without prior permission of the warden/ authority. They must use hostel uniform.***

- Taking part of all hostellers in any activity organized by the authority is compulsory.
- **Hostel security deposits** will only be refunded for those who have stayed for two years i.e. Class XI and XII sessions on regular basis (till the end of session). However, for incumbents who expelled from the hostel and could not fulfil the conditions for regular basis, the security deposit will not be refunded.
- ***Under any circumstances if a hosteller vacates the hostel before completion of the session, he/she has to pay the remaining monthly fee and other relevant fee for the full term.***
- ***Using of mobile phones, any electronic gadgets viz. Record players, radios, laptop, tablet vulgar magazines etc. is strictly prohibited, if detected by the warden/ authority the item/ items will be forfeited and must be fine as a punishment.***
- **Only two parents** of each hostellers are allowed to visit the hostel and meet their sons/ daughters/ wards once a months only on the last Sunday of the month during 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. They are also permitted to contact and talk to their sons/ daughters/ wards only through the hostel Warden No. When required under special/ unavoidable circumstances.
- Any crime committed by the hostellers inside/outside hostel is not responsible by the school authority.
- **Late coming** is not acceptable and penalties range from leave stop to detention, in addition to a fine for late joining amounting to **Rs. 1000/- per day** that your ward is late by., the parents co-operation in this regard is strongly solicited in case you would like your son/ward growing up in a disciplined manner, besides of course teaching him the values of punctuality in life.
- The school authority reserves the right to change/amend the Rules and Regulations at any point of time depending on the prevailing situation even without prior notice.
- Students should clear the remaining payable fees of the session if he/she is expelled from the hostel for any indisciplinary action.

LEAVE

- Residents may avail of the Home Leave for Vacations / Breaks / illness /unexpected reason.
- All types of leaves sought for weekdays have to be applied for at least 24 hours in advance. Hostellers can proceed on leave only after ensuring that leave is duly sanctioned by the Principal/Chief-Warden. Prior letter of request is to be furnished from LG/Parents in case home leave/leave for Special purposes/school vacations.
- Residents are required to sign in the appropriate register before proceeding on any kind of leave and on their return. Any resident found leaving or entering the hostel without signing the register is liable for disciplinary action.
- Every leave applied for and sanctioned has to be signed by Parent, LG and counter signed by the Chief-Warden (during school hour).
- Hostellers found forging signatures of parents/LG./fellow students will be expelled from the hostel.

VISITORS AND GUESTS

- Visitors must show an ID – Visitor Card to the security personal.
- Visiting Days will be on the last Sunday of every month during (9:00 AM. to 2:00 PM).

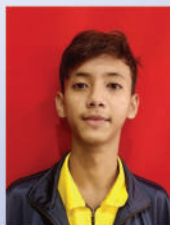

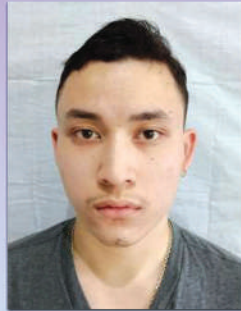

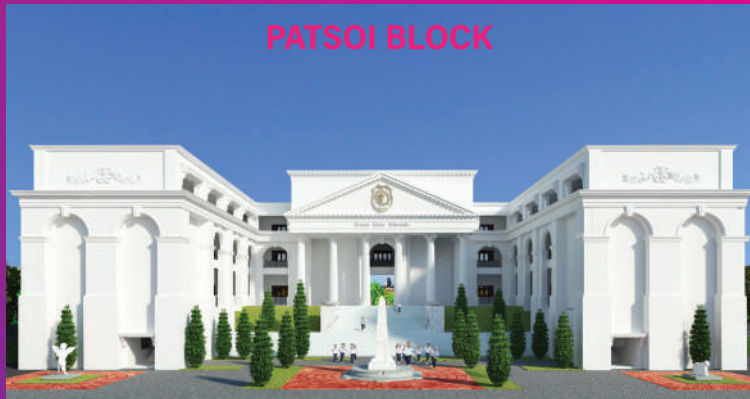
